Meeting Minutes

A meeting for all members of the anti-ragging committee was convened by the convenor on 24th June 2024 at 3.30 p.m. in the Sports Block Board Room. The following points were discussed during the meeting:

- The convenor of the committee expressed his gratitude to the members of the anti-ragging committee for the successful monitoring of the ragging activities in our campus. There were no such activities that happened in the previous academic year related to ragging.

- ii. The committee members shall act as squads to move around the campus to monitor the roaming and gathering of students and report to the convenor about the ragging activities held, if any, on any particular day.
- iii. The UGC published the regulations in 2009 to curb the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions. The aim of this regulation is to regulate the ragging in all the HEIs. It also has published continuous circulars to make the learning in HEIs enjoyable. The members are requested to kindly go through the website and to find the information as hosted by the UGC. - iv. The hot-spot areas are such as: lobbies, corridors, canteen, library, inside and outside of the premises of the institution, including the college buses. The members are requested to go on round to find any abnormal activities that are identified among the students leading to ragging activity.

 In this juncture, the UGC has created videos about ragging which can be found at: https://www.ugc.gov.in/page/videos-regarding-ragging.aspx. The members are informed to kindly share these videos to the students in order to have clarity about ragging.
- v. The members were informed to inform the students of the first years to create awareness that STC is popular for discipline and hence it is a "ragging-free

campus". The members are informed about ragging activity to the students. As per the definition of 'ragging' by the UGC as: "Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student." This must be informed to the students in order to create an awareness about what is ragging. The members were requested to inform the students not to indulge in ragging in any form, as it is a punishable offense.

- vi. The anti-ragging committee is formed as per the UGC requirement and the act of Government of Tamil Nadu. The students were also be informed about the existence of the committee in in the college. The members of the committee are nominated from the departments. Hence, the members can share the contact details of the committee to the students to contact any member without having any fear on such incidents, if any either inside the premises or outside. The detailed information about ragging is available in the college handbook.
- vii. As per the Government of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997, the ragger(s) will be punished as follows:
 - o Imprisonment up to a term of 2 years and
 - o A fine up to Rs.10,000/- and
 - The student convicted of ragging will be dismissed from the Institution and shall not be admitted in any other educational institution.

The meeting was concluded to make STC as a ragging-free campus and let the students have joyful learning in our campus.
