Rules and Regulations

Curriculum

Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS)

Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) is adopted by STC providing a flexible and student-centric learning platform for learning and acquiring higher education. The CBCS model empowers students to shape their education, ensuring a holistic and career-oriented academic experience.

It allows students to customize their learning experience by selecting courses based on their interests and career goals, encouraging both interdisciplinary learning and academic freedom.

Instead of a rigid syllabus, students can choose from:

- Core Courses: Mandatory subjects in the chosen program
- Elective Courses: Optional Subjects chosen based on personal interests.
- Allied and Non-Major Electives: Supportive subjects that complement the core which may not be directly related to the domain but add value to overall learning.
- Skill-Based Courses – Focused on industry-relevant practical skills.
- Value-Based Courses– Promote ethics, communication, and life skills.

Outcome-Based Education

STC has adopted and implemented Outcome-Based Education (OBE) model with effect from the academic year 2018-2019, focusing on student-centric approach that emphasizes measurable learning outcomes such as knowledge, skills, and attitudes.

Key Features of OBE:

- Clearly Defined Outcomes: Each program sets specific learning outcomes in advance.
- Aligned Curriculum: Teaching methods and assessments are structured to help students achieve these outcomes.
- Continuous Assessment: Student progress is regularly monitored to ensure required competencies are attained.

Eligibility to appear for the End Semester Examinations

A student will be allowed to appear for the end-semester examinations only if:

1. He/She procures atleast 75% of attendance.
2. He/She should show satisfactory progress in studies, in all the tests and examinations conducted by the college / department during the semester and secure at least reasonable minimum marks in them.
3. His/Her conduct in the college during the semester is satisfactory.

Evaluation System

The evaluation procedure at our College is designed to holistically assess the academic performance of students through a combination of internal assessments and end-semester examinations. The assessment system ensures continuous academic engagement and skill development across various domains.

1. Components of Evaluation

The evaluation system consists of two main components:

A. Internal Assessment (Formative Evaluation)

Internal assessment is designed to evaluate students' performance continuously throughout the semester. The internal assessment generally comprises:

- **Mid Semester Examinations I & II (or CIA - Continuous Internal Assessment)**

Conducted centrally during the academic term to assess students' understanding of the content covered. It helps identify learning gaps and reinforce learning outcomes.

Practical evaluation is carried out in labs with both internal and external components.

B. End Semester Examinations (Summative Evaluation)

End semester examinations are conducted at the conclusion of the academic term. These are comprehensive written exams based on the full syllabus. Examinations are conducted under the supervision of the Controller of Examinations and follow standard protocols for question paper setting, invigilation, valuation, and result publication.

Fees Regulation

Payment of Fees

1. The fees shall be paid in one lump sum not later than the 10th working day of each semester.
2. The pre-registration fees and the semester fees paid to college will not be refunded even if the student has attended one hour of classroom study.

Payment of fees with fine

If a student fails to pay the fees on the date fixed, a fine of ₹ 10 per working day shall be levied. If the fee is not paid within 20 days from the reopening of the college after the holidays, the student's name shall be removed from the rolls. Absence from college with/without leave letter shall not be the ground for exemption from the operation of this rule. If re-admitted, he/she shall, in addition to fees and fine, pay a re-admission fee of ₹ 2,500/- towards Bharathiar University.

Discipline Rules

Attendance and Leave

Every student shall follow strictly the leave rules given under. The Principal will take appropriate action in case of violation of leave rules.

1. No student shall abstain from the classes without prior permission.
2. In case of illness and other unforeseen circumstances, leave application should be handed over to the HOD on the first day of his/her return to the college.
3. A medical certificate should be produced to the Principal in case of leave due to prolonged illness (more than 5 days).
4. A student who absents from the class without any prior permission during any hour of the session will be considered as absent for that session.
5. Attendance certificate which is required for admission to the End Semester Examinations will be granted only if the student's progress and conduct have been satisfactory and the student has attended that required number of working days in that semester.
6. Leave of absence for Practical classes, Cycle tests and Model tests shall be granted if recommended by the staff concerned only.
7. Attendance will be marked for every hour by the staff member concerned.
8. Leaving the campus during class hours is allowed only with the permission of the Principal.

General Discipline

1. Every student should dress decently. Jeans are not allowed, Identity Card (ID) inside the college campus is compulsory.
2. Boys and Girls are instructed not to come to college with painted or coloured hair. Hair should be well groomed neat and tidy.
3. Students shall maintain silence within and outside the classrooms.
4. Students are not allowed to loiter in the corridor during the class hours.
5. Every student should greet the staff members on his / her first meeting of that day.
6. When a staff member enters the class room, the students shall rise up and greet them.
7. Any student who comes to class after the roll call, shall enter the classroom only with the permission of the class teacher concerned.
8. No student shall leave the classroom without the permission of the staff concerned before the class is dispersed.
9. Every student should handle the college property with care and do everything in his/her power to keep the class room clean and maintain the building and the premises spick and span.
10. Smoking and consumption of liquor / drugs inside the college campus is strictly prohibited and the offenders will be severely dealt with.

11. The students using two-wheelers should wear helmets compulsorily and possess the driving license without which they will not be allowed in the campus.
12. No student shall make the walls untidy or litter papers inside the campus/classrooms.
13. Students shall conduct themselves with dignity and decorum in all the functions of the college.
14. Students are not allowed to use mobile phone inside the campus for purposes other than online classes. Mobile phones will be seized from students violating the rules and strict action will be taken on them.
15. All the students are expected to read the information displayed on the notice board daily and regularly and keep them well informed and ignorance of any information will not be excused.

Library Rules

“A Library, is the delivery room for the birth of ideas – a place where history comes to life”. The Library is the heart-beat and the nerve Centre of any educational institution. STC has got the most modern and state-of-the-art library with a good collection of text books, reference books etc., numbering more than 46,000 volumes. More than 70 reputed National and International periodicals are being subscribed to provide latest information on the various subjects of study. In addition, several periodicals in CD-ROM form are also available. The Digital Library of the college has about 2,758 CDs, floppies and cassettes. Question papers of the University Examinations and all back volumes of the journals are made available for reference. The DELNET (Developing Library Net Work), INFLIBNET – N – List provides 10857 books and 234 E – journals titles. Database has been subscribed for the benefit of the students and staff. The DELNET provides 38184 E-journals, plenty of E-books on various subjects & statistical database for researchers and 1124250 articles which help the members to find their references. An exclusive Library for Commerce and Management has been established recently.

- The library is kept open from 08.30 am to 05.30 pm on all working days.
- Students/Staff should scan their ID card in the E-gate register while entering and leaving the library.
- Open Access System is followed, using which the members are allowed to go directly to the bookshelves and select the books.
- Strict silence should be maintained in the library and the reading room. Books are Issued from 08:35 am to 05.30 pm, except during class hours.
- Two additional books are provided for students who maintain 70% and above Borrowed books should be returned within 15 days from the date of issue.

- The student must produce his/her identity card at the time of borrowing books. Marking inside or damaging the books not allowed
- The borrowed books should be returned on or before the due date.
- Lost books can be replaced by submitting a copy of the new book with same title and author or paying double cost. If it is lost, then 5 times of the book amount will be collected as fine.
- If a book is not returned on the due date, an overdue charge of 50 paise per book / per day will be levied.
- Books should be returned only in the counter prescribed. Only loose papers and diary are allowed inside the library
- Personal books and files must be left at the library entrance rack /stand.
- Arrangement of chairs and other furniture in the reading area should not be disturbed.
- During Annual Day celebration “Best Library User Award” will be given to students who use library more.
- Competitive magazines are issued (Back volumes) for 3 days with additional one-time renewal.
- Signing in the usage slip of Journals and Magazines is compulsory.
- First Aid Box is available in the library.
- Digital Library- Library Computers are connected to the internet to support research and learning.
- Inter-Library Loan: We provide books and copies of books to other institutions through DELNET’s Inter-Library Loan service. Digital Library can be utilized for e-Books, DELNET and INFLIBNET use. Use of Mobile Phone is not allowed inside the library.
- All faculty members, scholars and students shall enroll as the members of NDLI Club

Industry Visit Rules

1. Industrial Visit shall be organized only to industries or organizations relevant to the students’ domain of study.

2. Prior approval from the Principal/Management and confirmation from the host industry must be obtained before organizing the visit.
3. The visit shall be conducted as a one-day programme with clearly defined academic and learning objectives.
4. Students must spend a minimum of three (3) hours within the industry premises for observation, learning, and interaction activities.
5. An expert talk or technical session by industry professionals shall be arranged as a mandatory component of the visit.
6. Adequate faculty members shall accompany and supervise students throughout the visit.
7. Students shall carry their College Identity Card and adhere to the prescribed dress code.
8. Attendance shall be mandatory for all registered participants and recorded throughout the programme.
9. Students shall maintain discipline, professionalism, and ethical conduct and follow all instructions provided by faculty coordinators and industry personnel.
10. Safety guidelines and regulations of the host industry shall be strictly followed at all times.
11. Photography, videography, or recording inside the industry shall be permitted only with prior approval from the industry authorities.
12. Consumption of alcohol, tobacco, or any prohibited substances and any form of misconduct are strictly prohibited.
13. Students shall actively participate in technical discussions, demonstrations, and interactions with industry experts.
14. The department shall ensure that the visit provides exposure to industrial processes, technologies, and career opportunities relevant to the programme.
15. A report containing attendance details, photographs, expert session summary, and learning outcomes shall be submitted by the department after the visit.
16. IV team shall carry a first aid kit with them

Hostel Rules

The warden will carry out the administration of the college hostels. The hostel rules are applicable to all the residents of the hostel and Principal's interpretation of the rules shall be final and binding.

General

1. The students are allowed to go out of the hostel only with the permission of the warden. Once the students come back, they should inform the warden immediately.
2. Students should report everyday to the hostel warden before 6 pm either he/she comes from the college or residence.
3. Students are allowed to go out of the hostel on Sundays from 8 am to 1 pm.
4. A Student movement register is maintained for documentation purpose.
5. Students are not allowed to conduct meeting or give notice or collect money from other students for any purpose or any kind of activity.
6. Hostel will remain closed on important occasions like Deepavali, Pongal festivals etc.,
7. Hostel will be closed during vacation.
8. Day-scholar students will not be permitted to enter the hostel under any circumstances.
9. Students are not allowed to stick pictures, draw or write on the walls.
10. If the hostel property is damaged, penalty fees towards damages will be collected from the students.

Fees

Hostel / Mess fees should be paid per annum and it will not be refunded for any reason.

Mess

1. All the students should follow the mess timings.
2. Food materials from the mess shall not be taken to the room or outside on any account.

Water

To conserve water and ensure its availability for all, inmates are instructed to avoid wastage of water.

Electricity

1. Power supply will be regulated if necessary. The cost of running the generator will be shared by the inmates on pro rata basis, and electricity charges should be paid at the end of the semester.
2. Students are instructed not to use any electrical/electronic instruments like radio, iron box, heater etc., in their rooms and use the facilities, fans and lights etc., judiciously. Students are required to follow the rules & regulations prescribed from time to time very strictly.
3. In all matters, the decision of the Principal shall be final and binding.

Transport Facilities

The college has well maintained buses plying to different areas to facilitate hassle-free travel for the students.

Student Dress Code Rules

To maintain a professional academic environment and promote discipline, all students are required to adhere to the prescribed dress code while on campus.

General Guidelines:

1. Students must wear neat, clean, and professional attire at all times.
2. Shirts must be properly tucked in while on campus.
3. College ID cards must be worn visibly at all times.
4. Torn, ripped, distressed, faded, or damaged jeans are strictly prohibited.
5. Jeans with holes, patches, frayed edges, excessive fading, or decorative cuts are not permitted.
6. Clothing that is revealing, transparent, sleeveless, or inappropriate for an academic environment is not allowed.
7. Casual wear, shorts, capris, joggers, and other informal attire are prohibited.
8. Students must wear formal shoes or clean, well-maintained shoes that complement the prescribed dress code.

Guidelines for Girl Students:

1. Wearing a shawl/dupatta or overcoat is mandatory with the prescribed attire.
2. Dress should be modest, professional, and suitable for an academic environment.

Weekly Dress Code:

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday: College uniform is mandatory.
- Wednesday: Uniform T-shirt and decent black colour cotton pants is mandatory.

Saturday

- Students may wear decent coloured dress/formal attire that maintains the dignity and professionalism of the institution.
- Students are expected to comply with the dress code at all times. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disciplinary action as per the institution's rules and regulations.

Anti-Ragging and Government order on Ragging

Ragging is totally banned in the college and it is a punishable offence. The Government of Tamil Nadu has banned ragging in Educational Institutions by passing an Order “Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act 1997” (vide its order No.7 of 14.02.1997) which says that indulging in ragging will be punished as follows :

1. Imprisonment upto a term of 2 years and
2. A fine upto Rs.10,000/- and
3. The student convicted of ragging will be dismissed from the Institution and shall not be admitted in any other educational institution.

Hence students are advised not to indulge in ragging and stay away from such activities but rise up against this evil.

Anti Drug Committee (ADC)

Anti-Drug Clubs (ADC) were launched in the year 2022, with the primary objective to create awareness among students regarding the ill effects of drug abuse. The motto of the ADC is “DRUG FREE TAMIL NADU”

Pledge Against Drug Abuse

- I am aware of the ill effects of drug abuse and I solemnly promise not to indulge in drug abuse. I also swear my sincere contribution to prevent and advise my family members and friends not to fall into the habit of drug abuse. I assure to fully contribute for the cause of rescuing and guiding the drug abusers to give up drugs.
- I will fully stand with the Government in their fight against the usage, consumption, and manufacturing of illegal narcotic substances in order to eradicate them from Tamil Nadu.
- I affirm to contribute with utmost dedication towards the growth of the State and Welfare of its people.

POSH Act 2013

An Act to provide protection against sexual harassment of women at workplace and for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.

- WHEREAS sexual harassment results in violation of the fundamental rights of a woman to equality under articles 14 and 15 of the Constitution

of India and her right to life and to live with dignity under article 21 of the Constitution and right to practice any profession or to carry on any occupation, trade or business with includes a right to a safe environment free from sexual harassment;

- AND WHEREAS the protection against sexual harassment and the right to work with dignity are universally recognised human rights by international conventions and instruments such as Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination against Women, which has been ratified on the 25th June, 1993 by the Government of India;
- AND WHEREAS it is expedient to make provisions for giving effect to the said Convention for protection of women against sexual harassment at workplace.

Disciplinary Action under Tamilnadu Educational Rules

The attention of all the students is drawn to the following Tamilnadu Educational rules:

1. Principal or other constituted authorities of the college may frame and issue from time to time the disciplinary rules of permanent or temporary nature regulating the conduct of the students in and outside the college premises in so far as such rules seem necessary to maintain the reputation of the institution.
2. Principal or other constituted authorities shall have full power to inflict the following punishments in the interest of the students or in the interest of the institution such as fines, loss of attendance, forfeiture of term certificates, suspension etc.

In pursuance of UGC (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher education institution) Regulations, 2015 read with Sexual Harassment of Women at workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) is constituted to deal with the complaints relating to sexual harassment of women at work place.

The committee shall take all necessary and appropriate action to deal with any form of sexual harassment of women at the work place and also for the prevention and redressal of complaints of sexual harassment subject to the provisions of the said Act as and when any complaint is filed by women employees working in the College. It is to be noted that sexual harassment includes any one or more of the following unwelcome acts and behaviour, whether directly or indirectly, namely:-

1. Physical contact and advances; or
2. A demand or request for sexual favours; or
3. Making sexually coloured remarks; or
4. Showing pornography; or
5. Any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature.

Students' Grievances Redressal Cell

'Students helpline to address various issues and lodge their complaints with this helpline'.

The Students Grievances Redressal Cell is functioning in the college from the year 2001. The cell functions with an objective of solving the grievances of the students. The complaints received from the students are analyzed by the members of the committee and are brought to the notice of the principal for further action. Members of the committee hear the problems of the grieved patiently and take remedial steps accordingly. It also functions as a counseling cell whenever personal problems are reported. The committee maintains a record of its activities for reference.

Women's Empowerment and Compliance Committee

This Committee was constituted in 2006 as per the Supreme Court guidelines 2004.

Women Empowerment Complaint Committee is functioning based on the following objectives

- To protect the safety of girl students of our College as per the order of the Supreme Court in the year 2004 and empower women students.
- To prevent or deter the commission of acts of sexual harassment and to provide the procedures for the resolution, settlement or prosecution of acts of sexual harassment of girl students by taking all steps required.
- To express prohibition of sexual harassment inside the campus by notification, publication and circulation in appropriate ways.
- To submit an annual report to the principal regarding the complaints and action taken by the committee.

SC/ST Welfare Committee

(Example: If the result date is the 8th, the deadline for submission of applications shall be the 12th)
- The selection results will be announced within three days after the last date of application submission (i.e., on the 9th day from the date of result publication) as specified by the Secretary (If needed).
- Selected candidates must pay the admission and association fees alone within two days from the date of result announcement.
- Failure to remit the fees within the stipulated time will lead to automatic cancellation of admission, and the seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate on the merit list.
- Applicants must have secured 90% and above in the Higher Secondary Examination in core subjects (excluding language papers).
- The selection process is purely merit-based.
- The affidavit must be signed by the applicant only after thoroughly reading and understanding its contents.
